






DISTINCTIVE LEGACY




SIESTA


Siesta was born from Hiort af Ornäs' pursuit for a perfect lounge chair that would suit any interior and resemble a comfortable lap to rest in. The distinctive design, perfectly balanced sculptural form and carefully considered functionality have made the Siesta lounge chair a true classic. Originally designed in 1952, Siesta still offers its embracing ergonomics today.

Hiort af Ornäs painstakingly perfected the Siesta chair for years before it reached its final organic form in 1952. He created numerous wax-moulded and plaster cast models and a series of prototypes that he kept refining during his quest for perfection.

Before launching the Siesta lounge chair, Hiort af Ornäs asked his employees to sit reading and knitting in the chair for hours, then probed them in detail about how comfortable they found it. The curves of the backrest and angle of the seat are designed to offer ideal support while sitting, and the delicate design charms with its harmonious beauty.







RIALTO

The sculptural Rialto lounge chair is a masterpiece in carpentry. Originally designed for the Milan Triennial in 1957, Rialto combines streamlined design with carefully finished details.

With his background in architecture Hiort af Ornäs approached furniture design like a sculptor. His furniture looks beautiful from any angle, often revealing intriguing details in the most surprising places. No need to hide anything against a wall – Rialto is like a sculpture that can be placed in any part of a room. The streamlined design and sophisticated details engage in a fascinating dialogue. The braided leather straps at the back and curved legs shaped from a single piece of wood give Rialto its unique appearance.

The final look of the chair depends on the selected wood type, upholstery and back and armrest finish. The frame is available in three options: oak, birch, mahogany and walnut. The backrest can be chosen in exquisite leather braiding or stunning raw linen. The versatile Rialto lounge chair suits any space and ambience.

VÄLIPALA

The Välipala shelf unit designed in the late 1950s insightfully showcases Hiort af Ornäs' aim for unique design. The name means 'snack' in Finnish, referring to the middle blocks that can be arranged between the shelves according to one's liking to create numerous combinations.

Välipala's light and airy, ingenuous design stems from sophisticated, carefully thought-out solutions. The middle blocks taper towards the front, which creates a lovely interplay of light and shadow. The discreet details form an elegant backdrop that accentuates displayed books and favourite objects. The handcrafted shelves are available in several widths, making the shelf unit adaptable for larger and smaller rooms alike. You can easily reassemble and extend the shelf unit and rearrange the divisions. Hiort af Ornäs designed Välipala as a storage solution for modern homes. It turned out to be much more – a contemporary classic.

MANDARIINI

The revolving Mandariini lounge chair combines a futuristic form with a timeless appeal. Designed in 1960, the chair plays with contrasts, juxtaposing industrial steel with natural solid wood. Its cup-like rotating seat is connected to a hardwood-lined steel leg. This visually intriguing, comfortable and durable chair is a perfect choice for both homes and public spaces.


The seat of the Mandariini chair is reminiscent of Japanese origami. Hiort af Ornäs once said that during the design phase he would sit at his kitchen table night after night cutting and folding paper in an effort to design a cone-shaped chair. "I played with the idea of a cone and the different ways it could be cut for a couple of years. I kept thinking about it because a plywood press can easily cut out a cone." Mandariini is testament to the manufacturing process being an endless source of inspiration for the designer.

The streamlined leg structure counterbalances the curved shape of the seat. "I thought about a traditional English horse carriage, which became a starting point for the model. The curved forms of a cone need to be balanced with straight lines."

NÄYTTELY DISPLAY CABINET

The Näyttely display cabinet juxtaposes elegant beauty with multifunctionality. Light flows freely through the glass doors and walls, giving the cabinet with a solid wood structure a light and airy feel.

The hand-cut glass shelves make sure vignettes of treasured objects stand in the limelight, while the glass doors protect books and tableware from dust. The cabinet is suitable for many uses and different rooms in the home. With its beautiful finish on the back, Näyttely can also be used as a room divider. Hiort af Ornäs originally designed the Näyttely display cabinet in 1955 as an interior element for Finnish embassies. Each cabinet is still handmade in Finland to the finest detail using the same original methods. The versatile cabinet suits different types of interiors depending on the selected type of wood, surface finishing and material at the back. Oak, walnut, mahogany and pale Scandinavian birch can be combined equally well with raw linen or black, clear or mirrored glass.




We value natural materials that age beautifully and last from one generation to another – a timeworn patina adding another layer of beauty with its stories to tell. Wood is both our passion and endless source of inspiration – just like it was for Hiort af Ornäs when he created the very first Ornäs pieces in the 1940s. We specialise in solid wood, ranging from pale Scandinavian to darker wood qualities. Seeing how the wood quality influences the final appearance of a product is always a fascinating process. Every Ornäs piece is available in four options: oak, birch, mahogany and walnut.

In upholstered products, the selected fabric determines the final appearance. Tightly woven wool, exclusive bouclé or soft and smooth velvet will look and feel different. The world of fabrics is almost endless, and many of our products are available by special order in a wide variety of fabrics. To help your decision, we have curated our recommendations for each Ornäs piece. We primarily use upholstery fabrics from Kvadrat and Lauritzon.














CARL GUSTAF HIORT AF ORNÄS (1911-1996)

Carl Gustaf Hiort af Ornäs was driven by an honest desire to create unprecedented pieces of furniture. The Finnish designer who followed his own international path was an uncompromising idealist who refined his products in pursuit of perfection.

His work as a designer was guided by a respect and profound understanding of wood. In addition to a distinctive aesthetic, he was passionate about manufacturing methods. He told his children that he founded his own company to see how his ideas could be transformed into three-dimensional objects.

Hiort af Ornäs strived to design modern furniture that reflected contemporary trends but had a timeless quality. In the process, he developed new, ground-breaking manufacturing techniques and came to hold several international patents. Established in 1945, his joinery workshop Puunveisto Oy developed the world's first plywood bending machine that could bend plywood in three different directions at the same time. From the 1940s to 1970s, seamless cooperation between the designer and skilled cabinetmakers resulted in unique, high-quality furniture with a special sculptural aesthetic and refined details.

Ornäs continues the unique life's work of Finnish designer Carl-Gustaf Hiort af Ornäs and holds the design copyrights for all furniture designed by him.


All of the genuine Ornäs classics are crafted at our workshop based on his original drawings.
